



## ***From Pastor Thea***

Dear Friends of God in Christ,

In one of our Sunday Lenten readings we are reminded of Abraham's call from God to start a new adventure. God came to Abram (Abram's name later changes to Abraham) and said to him, "I want you to pull up stakes and head out into open country. Don't worry about your destination. I will fill you in on the details as you go along." Abram would have had every reason to say, "Wait a minute, Lord. You do not know what you are asking. I have a good life here in Haran. I am respected in my community, have a good income, many fine friends. My wife is happy here. My father is buried here. And on top of that, I am 75 years old."

**Life is an adventure.** It starts from the very moment of birth as an infant enters a new and unfamiliar universe. The adventure continues as friends are made, schools are selected, careers are begun and mates are chosen. Life is an adventure because there is always the element of the unknown in anything new that is begun. We begin new things on FAITH...faith that whatever the journey happens to be, somehow it will turn out all right. For people of faith there is a certain comfort in taking adventurous steps because we believe we do not take those steps alone. As the Psalmist has said, "My times are in Your hands."

Abram believed that. We can believe that also.

This month the adventure continues. For me personally, I have been called into the adventure of interim ministry - a ministry that has called me into relationship with you. In one sense I have come home. I grew up in Fargo. I am enjoying being back in big sky territory and the beautiful plains and farm country of my earlier years. My home is in the lakes area of the Chippewa National Forest in Minnesota. I have often heard the people of that area say that they live in "God's country." The magnificent plains are God's country too.

You also are called by the Spirit of God into an adventure. You are called into relationship with the Triune God, with one another, with this amazing coming together of seven churches known as Tri-County, and with this creation that God has placed into our hands to care for. As we continue this journey and this adventure unfolds, we may hear ourselves say, "Wait a minute, Lord. You do not know what you are asking." At those moments let us remember and have faith in the words, "My times are in Your hands...Don't worry...I will fill you in on the details as you go along."

I want to close by thanking ALL of you for the warm hospitality you have given to this stranger. I look forward to meeting more of you and to our ministry together.
