The six ELCA congregations of TCM have completed their collections for this special project of World Hunger. A total of **\$1,682.20** was received! The money was spent by each congregation as designated:



- ◆ Our Savior's of Klotten — 2 pigs and 7 chicks
- ◆ Lutheran Church of McVille — 2 pigs, 2 goats, 30 chicks
- ◆ Trinity of Binford — 1 farm, 1 duck, 1 sheep, 2 mosquito nets
- ◆ Faith of Hannaford — 10 chicks, 1 pig, 1 alpaca, 1 sheep, 1 goat (will be adding more)
- ◆ Our Savior's of McHenry — 30 chicks, malaria medicine to treat 25 people, 3 mosquito nets
- ◆ Grace of Grace City — 2 goats, 20 chicks
