From Pastor Sherri

God sent Elijah into the desert during a drought. But not to die — the ravens fed Elijah bread and meat in the morning and in the evening, as instructed by God. Then, God sent Elijah to stay with a widow to whom God had already instructed to house and feed the prophet upon his arrival. Elijah found the widow preparing a last meal for herself. Without the means to buy any food, she and her son would starve to death before the end of the drought. “God told me that you will have enough food to live through this drought,” Elijah told her. Then the widow’s son became so ill that he stopped breathing. The prophet stretched out the boy on the bed and cried out to God, “Let this child’s life come into him again!”

Do we feel that God has led Tri-County Ministry out into the desert to die? Do we feel we have enough means for one more meal and then it is over for our parish? Do we feel that our churches have stopped breathing?

Elijah did not give up. He laid the boy on the bed and cried out to God. The leadership of Trinity-Binford and Lutheran Church of McVille have entered into an intentional time of prayer, study of scripture, listening for God’s voice and dreaming for these congregations. With the help of the Eastern ND Synod and a process called “Vital Signs”, we are embarking on intentional transformation. This is a spiritual process and we are re-rooting ourselves in the good news of Jesus Christ by bringing God’s promised future for this ministry into focus. This is God’s project among us not only for these two congregations, nor only for our parish. This project is about Jesus changing the world. This process comes with expectations and accountability; therefore the TCM Council has given their blessing and signed a Covenant of Transformation. Where is God leading us? How is the Holy Spirit breathing new life into us?

The Lord listened to Elijah’s voice and breathed life into the boy. When Elijah presented the boy to his mother she cried, “*Now I know you are a man of God, and that the word of the Lord in your mouth is true!*” (1 Kings 17:1-24)

VITAL SIGNS: Pastor Jess gave a presentation on this process being offered by the END Synod. Vital Signs is a two-year process with a Transformation Team of 4-6 people from the participating parish or congregation. \$1000 investment in the program, which begins this fall of 2019. The opportunity to participate was offered to Tri-County Ministry.

REVIEW OF MUTUAL MINISTRY REPORT

Worship Scheduling Committee: Report was given by Linda Loe. Committee met twice and created a new schedule for Sunday worship services, using the worship times of 8:30 and 10:30 throughout the parish. Committee recommended adoption of new schedule. Motion seconded by Sheila Beglau to adopt the new schedule, with Trinity/Our Savior's McHenry/Grace working together on scheduling for their triad. Motion carried.

Motion by Connie Eslinger, seconded by Myrna Hanson that new worship schedule begin in October for Our Savior's Klotten/Lutheran Church of McVillage/First Presbyterian of Cooperstown/Faith of Hannaford, and that the triad of Trinity/Our Savior's/Grace be allowed an extra month to meet and plan a cooperative worship schedule using the 8:30/10:30 worship times. Motion carried.

Staff Model: Discussion of current responsibilities of the SAMs. They lead worship, do visitation, attend lay ministry gatherings, and lead various committees in the parish. Question of whether our SAM program could be grown.

Discussion of what an associate or administrative staff member might include on a job description. Pastor Sherri and Theresa will create a possible list of responsibilities and will submit it to the Executive Committee via e-mail before October 3. Sherri's list will include "what I wish I could do if I had time."

At this time Pastor Jess excused herself from the meeting.

VITAL SIGNS: Motion by Linda Loe, seconded by Denny Goetz, that Tri-County Ministry invest in the Vital Signs process this fall. Motion failed.

Motion by Linda Loe, seconded by Denny Goetz, that individual congregations wishing to participate in Vital Signs would do so with the support of the Tri-County Ministry Council, knowing that an annual 1% increase in synod mission support is expected; request may be made to the Tri-County Ministry Foundation for the monetary investment in the program. Motion carried.

NEXT MEETING: Tuesday, October 8, 6:00 at Trinity. Main agenda item: 2020 TCM budget
